

**Handwriting Expectations at Marden Vale**  
**Statutory requirements for handwriting**

**EYFS**

Physical development

- Shows a preference for a dominant hand.
- Begins to use anticlockwise movement and retrace vertical lines.
- Begins to form recognisable **non cursive** letters.
- Uses a pencil and holds it effectively to form recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.

Literacy

- **Writes own name** and other things such as labels, captions.

**Y1 Pupils should be taught to:**

- sit correctly at a table, holding a pencil comfortably and correctly
- begin to form **non cursive** lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place
- form capital letters
- form digits 0-9
- understand which letters belong to which handwriting 'families' (i.e. letters that are formed in similar ways) and to practise these.

**Write first and surname using appropriate upper and lower case letters**

**Y2 Pupils should be taught to:**

- form lower-case letters of the correct size relative to one another
- start using some of the diagonal and horizontal strokes needed to **join** letters and understand which letters, when adjacent to one another, are best left unjoined
- write capital letters and digits of the correct size, orientation and relationship to one another and to lower case letters
- use spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters.

**Y3/4 Pupils should be taught to:**

- use the diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters and understand which letters, when adjacent to one another, are best left unjoined
- increase the legibility, consistency and quality of their handwriting [for example, by ensuring that the downstrokes of letters are parallel and equidistant; that lines of writing are spaced sufficiently so that the ascenders and descenders of letters do not touch].

**Y5/6 Pupils should be taught to:**

- write legibly, fluently and with increasing speed by:
- choosing which shape of a letter to use when given choices and deciding whether or not to join specific letters
- choosing the writing implement that is best suited for a task.
