PSHE

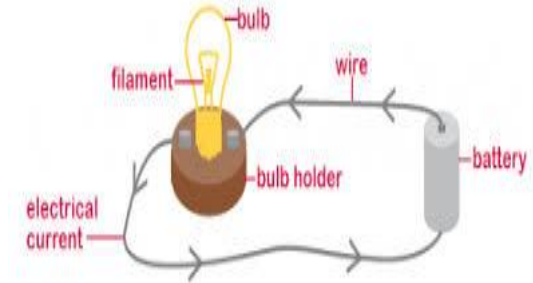

We will be learning about computer systems and networks.

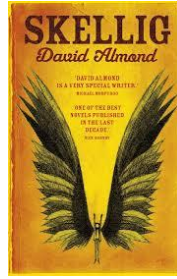
Value of the Term



English

Reading

This term we will continue reading Skellig by David Almond.



Writing

We will be reviewing and revising some of our earlier pieces of writing. We will also be writing a narrative, focusing carefully on our use of dialogue to convey character and advance the action.

SPaG

We will be focusing on using different techniques to create cohesion in our writing.

Spellings

Statutory words will remain a focus. Will will also be looking at homophones and the following spelling suffixes: -ence and -ance; -ent, -ence and -ency.

Handwriting

Cursive writing is a requirement of the national curriculum therefore we shall continue to develop this in handwriting lessons via Letter-join and during our writing and SPaG lessons.

DT

We will be focusing on food technology this term by revisiting and learning new important skills. These will include hygiene and safety. There will be a clear focus on how we can make balanced and healthy meals.



Maths

We will be continuing our learning on measure by looking at the following:

- *Shapes with the same area*
- *Area and perimeter*
- *Finding missing lengths from area and perimeter*
- *Finding the area of triangles*
- *Finding the area of parallelograms*
- *Problem solving with perimeter and area*

We will then move on to statistics, where we will be interpreting line graphs, bar charts and pie charts. This will require us to draw on our knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages.
